## 1.0 Introduction

This document provides the instructions to perform a feature upgrade on the DM240XR using the appropriate Compact Flash Card.

## 2.0 Required Items

Compact Flash Card (CF)

## 3.0 Feature Upgrade

Once the customer has the appropriate Compact Flash Card, perform the following steps:

1. Power off the unit.
2. Remove the firmware CF from J5.
3. Install the CF Card with feature upgrade into J5 (memory card) at the rear of the DM240XR as shown in Figure 1.
4. Power on the unit.
5. Observe the Remote LED (green) on the front panel illuminates. When the feature upgrade is complete, the front panel will indicate "Successful".
6. Power off the unit.
7. Remove the feature upgrade CF.
8. Reinstall the firmware CF into J5 and secure with clip.
9. Power on the unit and verify through the front panel that the upgrades have been applied.  
**Note: If the Fault LED (red) illuminates, contact the Customer Service Department.**
