COMTECH EF DATA AND MITEQ SETTLE LAWSUIT

TEMPE, Arizona, March 3, 2004 – Comtech EF Data Corporation (Comtech), a subsidiary of Comtech Telecommunications Corporation (NASDAQ: CMTL), and Miteq, Inc. (Miteq) have settled a lawsuit brought by Comtech against Miteq alleging that Comtech's U.S. Patent 5,666,646 ("the '646 patent") is infringed by Miteq's 9700 converter with Prioritized Chain Redundancy (the -1 Option). Miteq believes that the '646 patent is invalid and not infringed. Miteq, however, has discontinued its 9700 Converter with the -1 Option and therefore, agreed to settle the lawsuit. Miteq has agreed not to re-introduce the discontinued product into the marketplace; in particular, Miteq has agreed not to manufacture, sell, or offer for sale the 9700 Converter with Prioritized Chain Redundancy (the -1 Option) except to service, maintain and extend existing systems on a limited basis and to meet an existing contractual obligation for a United States military program. Miteq has also agreed not to transfer the design to others to manufacture the disputed product.
